They come as they have for thousands of years to this stretch of the Platte River—more than 600,000 Sandhill Cranes in all—to rest, feed and congregate in astonishing numbers before pushing on to their breeding grounds in the north. Now, as never before, you can experience the wonder of North America's great Sandhill Crane migration on rare Crane Trust lands in the heart of Nebraska.

These Crane Trust lands are also home to a large herd of genetically-pure American bison which were reintroduced in 2014 to become a natural part of grazing, burning, and resting of the land. American bison once coexisted with the cranes before settlement and were instrumental in shaping this critical habitat along the Platte River.

Come immerse yourself in this captivating and rare ecosystem, which has been preserved by the Crane Trust to mirror the unique and extraordinary habitat used for millennia by the endangered Whooping Cranes and the Sandhill Cranes.



EXTRAORDINARY LEGACY

The Crane Trust was created in 1978 as part of a court-approved settlement over the construction of Grayrocks Dam on a tributary of the Platte River more than 400 miles upriver in Wyoming. The State of Nebraska and the National Wildlife Federation objected to the project, claiming it would jeopardize irrigation and wildlife downstream in Nebraska.



The Crane Trust's mission is to protect and maintain the physical, hydrological and biological integrity of the Big Bend area of the Platte River so that it continues to function as a life support system for Whooping Cranes, Sandhill Cranes and other migratory bird species.

Since 1978, the Crane Trust has protected over 20,000 acres of land and currently maintains and protects 10,000 acres.
